HISTORY



On July 7, 2012, then-vice President of China, Xi Jinping, addressed the Opening ceremony of the first WPF.

Founded in 2012, the World Peace Forum (WPF) is organized by Tsinghua University and co-organized by the Chinese People's Institute of Foreign Affairs (CPIFA). As the first high-level international security forum initiated by a Chinese institution, the WPF was institutionalized in 2013 as a non-governmental annual summer event, aiming to offer an opportunity for international strategists and think-tank leaders to discuss international security issues and develop constructive approaches to dealing with threats to international security.

In the past ten years, a total of 68 (former) foreign dignitaries have been present at the World Peace Forum.
