Founded in 2012, the World Peace Forum (WPF) is organized by Tsinghua University and co-organized by the Chinese People's Institute of Foreign Affairs (CPIFA). As the first high-level international security forum initiated by a Chinese institution, the WPF was institutionalized in 2013 as a non-governmental annual summer event, aiming to offer an opportunity for international strategists and think-tank leaders to discuss international security issues and develop constructive approaches to dealing with threats to international security.





Climate and Multilateralism

The world is faced with unprecedented challenges and risks from climate change. As global temperature is expected to rise to record levels in the next five years, Mr. António Guterres, UN Secretary-General, calls for a global reset on climate action. For a global sustainable security, how to advance pragmatic multilateral climate cooperation under the UN framework? What commitments, actions are needed to ensure we can accelerate actions to achieve the SDGs and the commitments in the Paris Agreement? How can the multilateral system work better to ensure that nationally determined contributions are in line with the ambitions of the Paris Agreement? 


